Summer Day Camp: Currently sixteen campers enrolled. Many more campers will register prior to the start of camp. Beaches: Mrs. Lonergan has been in contact with Youth Assistance Program in Tilton. Volunteers are being coordinated to help rake Hermit Beach. Swimming classes are filling and once again Nicholas Sereni will instruct classes this year. Mrs. Lonergan also updates that the BOS approved purchasing a new shed for Winnisquam Beach. The highway department will be removing the old building.
