Meeting minutes from October 12, 2010 were read. **Motion:** A motion was made by Mrs. Wood and seconded by Mrs. Goodwin to accept the meeting minutes with minor corrections. **Vote:** Affirmative – Unanimous

Financials: The Commission reviewed monthly financial paperwork.

B&A Program: The numbers in the program were reviewed and discussed. On average current enrollment is down by 29.5 % and revenue is down by 29%. The program is running efficiently and numbers are expected to increase as the year goes on. Lonergan presented a comparison sheet on what other local Parks & Rec's and private day care centers are charging for B&A care programs. The commission took the information under advisement and will continue to monitor the program and consider changes to staff and fees.

Halloween: The Halloween party went very well. Thanks to all the support from the WRHS Student Council. They help set up, run and clean up for the event. Also Lonergan thanked Surowiec Farm for their donation of cider and apples, and thanked Guy Guinta Jr. for letting us use hay for a nice fall theme display.

Budget: The Commission is scheduled to present the budget to the BOS on Wednesday, December 8th. Goodwin apologized but will not be available that evening. Wood and Cray stated they should be able to attend.

Basketball: Lonergan updated that there were five traveling teams this year. The following is a breakdown per grade enrolled: K=5, 1st=10, 2nd=9, 3rd & 4th Girls=9, 3rd & 4th Boys=10, 5th & 6th Girls=15, 5th & 6th Boys 13. Lonergan will continue to accept children until the uniform order is placed.

Winter Celebration: Scheduled for Sunday, December 5th at 3:30 pm at the Old Town Hall. Mary Ruth Scott once again will lead us in song. Lonergan has craft and cookie decorating activities planned. The Girl Scouts have once again offered to make cookies. The Commission will be serving hot chocolate and popcorn. Lonergan stated that admission is free but a donation of canned items, for the local food pantry is requested. Lonergan also will ask Santa to come take Christmas wishes.

Ice Skating: December 5th and 12th; 6:00 – 8:00 p.m. Open skate. The "Learn to Skate Program" starts on January 2nd, 2011 and run for seven consecutive weeks. 5:15 – 6:00 p.m. "Parent Teach Your Child to Skate Time", 6:00 -7:00 p.m. Family Skate, 7:00 – 8:00 p.m. Open Skate.
