Financials: The Commission reviewed October, November, December and January revenues and expenses. Lonergan updated that the first installment payment of \$26,723.25 was made to the Town. Payment for guaranteed revenue reimbursement to the Town for the 2014-2015 fiscal budget.

Before & After School: Program continues to thrive. The director's assistance is taking a bigger part in planning activities and projects.

Gunstock Outreach program: This year there are twenty-eight skiers and boarders in the program. The program combines with the Pines Community Center as a minimum of twenty are needed to run the program. Sanbornton and Pines each have fourteen participants. Due to icy roads, we did cancel one night and we will make up in March.

Youth Basketball: Grades three- sixth are winding down the regular season. This year we had one each of the 3rd & 4th Grade Girls and Boys Teams. We also had one 5th & 6th boys' team as our 5th grade girls joined the Pines Team in Northfield. Tournament season is starting and the third and fourth grade all-star team will play in the Franklin and Gilford tournaments. The fifth and six-grade boys' team will play only in the Gilford tournament this year.

Winterfest: February vacation activities coordinator Lonergan will work with the Librarian on a snowshoe activity day on Wednesday, February 25th from 1 to 3 PM. Open gym sessions will be held at the WRMS from 5-8pm.

Ice-Skating: This year the crowd at Tilton School has a large number of younger adults utilizing the ice. This is a great place for them as there is not much offerings in the area that are free and a safe supervised location.

Boston Flower Show Trip: The trip so far has 10 people signed up. Lonergan anticipates more will be coming. On the trip Lonergan will be seeking ideas from those on attending where else they might like to go. This is a great way to reach adults and seniors in our community.

K-1 Basketball: This program is scheduled to start at the end of the month at the WRMS and continue until Saturday, April 25th. This is a skill-based basketball program focusing on skills and drills.

Youth Volleyball Kevin Archibald has once again volunteered to run a clinic for grades three through five fifth at SCS.

T-Ball: The program will be held on Tuesday and Thursday evenings at the Town Park field. We are scheduled to start on Thursday, April 9th and end on Tuesday, June 9th. This will depend on the field conditions.
