- Price of SS is jumping. We need to make sure that we have a contract
- MSW price is going up \$120 ensure that Sanbornton has locked into a contract.
- On January 1, electronics are supposed to go up 8-10%. Again check our budget for this line item and ensure we have a contract locked in.
- On Nov. 1, electronics will be going up per pound. If Sanbornton has a load ready to go, we need to get rid of it.
- Grants: New Hampshire the Beautiful is at the end of this year's grant year and will be starting
 a new year in November. Sanbornton should apply for a grant to assist with the purchase of
 the MSW Compactor.
- Tara made a strong suggestions to relay this information to the BOS as soon as possible to let them know what is going on. She also strongly suggested that a Sanbornton representative attend the NRRA monthly M.O.M. Meetings.
